

Fire alarms

- The building has a fire alarm system that incorporates automatic fire detection.
- A fire alarm call point is located at every staircase or external exit door.
- If you discover a fire and the fire alarm is not yet sounding, then raise the alarm by pressing the fire alarm call point.
- The sound will be a siren.
- Visual warning signals are provided.

Fire exits

- On hearing or seeing the fire alarm sounding make your way to the nearest available safe exit route and leave the building without delay.
- Use the nearest available safe exit route and leave the building without delay.
- Proceed via the nearest available safe exit route and leave the building without delay.

Fire assembly point

- Make your way to the designated fire assembly point. This will be identified in the building fire action notice.
- Do not reenter the building.
- Wait at the assembly point until you are informed by the Evacuation Officer or University Security that it is safe to return to the building.
