Such issues include the transferring of funds to partners in these countries if any there is any US involvement. Placed further advice and assistance through Research Services to discuss what processes or licences can potentially be put in place to be able to work with these countries.

The DD process is split into two distinct stages. The first stage is checks conducted prior at the application stage. This initial stage of checks are shorter and afee lighter touch primarily to gather basic information on the partner and to highlight any potential issues or red flags with working with the partner.
